General format:

Author, A. A., Author, B. B., & Author, C. C. (year). Title of article. *Title of Periodical*, volume number(issue number), page numbers. doi:xx.xxxxxxxxxx

Journal article with Digital Object Identifier (DOI):

Journal article without DOI:
